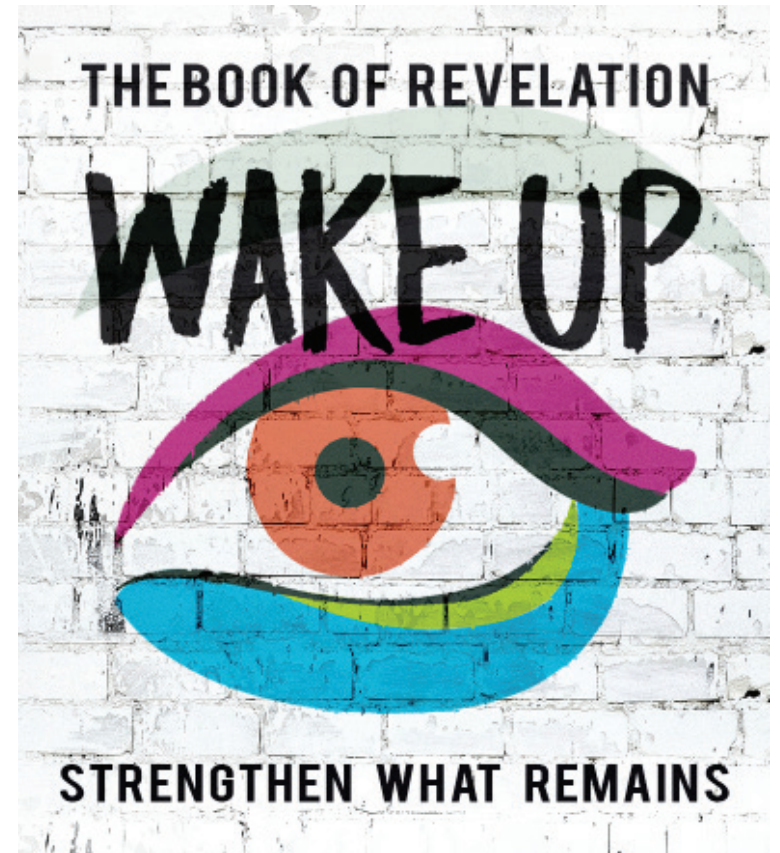

Please be aware that PBC pastors and staff will not send you messages asking for money (such as gift cards) or private personal information. If you receive such a request, please do not reply; even if it appears to come from the PBC person, it is actually from a criminal trying to deceive you. If in doubt, contact the purported sender directly by means you trust (not by replying to the suspicious message). You may alert us to such messages by sending an email to [info@pbc.org](mailto:info@pbc.org).

It is wise to be careful with all messages like these, even with no PBC reference. Many scams are out there, and they can look very legitimate.

We were alerted this week to emails pretending to be from Scott Grant asking for gift cards, so we know PBCers are being targeted.
