

**THEOLOGICAL**

- What eternal truth does this text teach?
- What does the text mean **ALWAYS**?

**EXEGETICAL**

- What did the original text mean to the original audience?
- What did the text mean **THEN**?

**HOMILETICAL**

- What application does this text have for an audience today?
- What does the text mean **NOW**?



**Skills: Exegetical Summary**

- Prose paragraph summarizing the main ideas you gleaned from the passage.
- What is the original author's "arrow"? (the overarching idea that they are trying to communicate)
- Call out the main idea and explain how the various parts of the passage contribute to or support this main idea.
- Becomes starting point for making sure that you choose the most significant idea from the passage for a preaching outline.


### The Spirit in the Church
